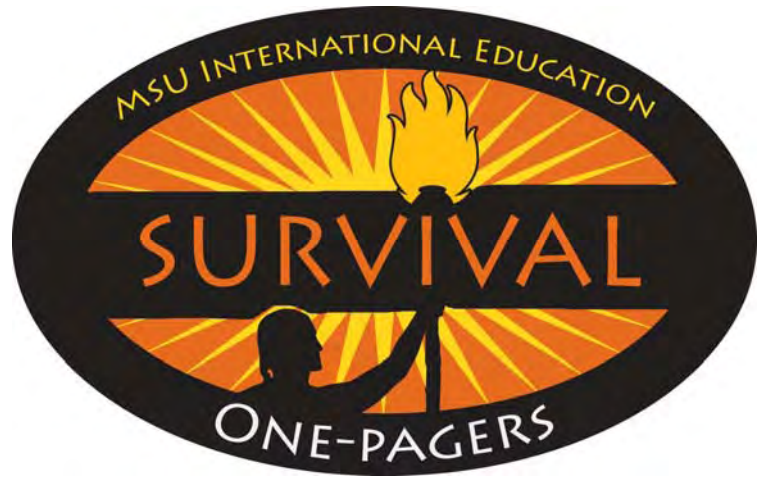


Bicycles on Campus

MSU provides bicycles free-of-charge for students to ride on campus. If you ride your personal bicycle on campus, however, it should be registered. Find out below where, why and how you should register your bike!



“May I ride one of the maroon and white bicycles?”

Yes, you may! MSU has provided 200 maroon and white bicycles for any student, staff or faculty member to use. If you see one not in use by someone, you may hop on and ride it anywhere on campus.

“What does it mean to register my bike, and why should I register it?”

Registering your bike simply means giving your name and address to the MSU Office of Parking Services along with your bicycle’s make, model, color, and serial number. If your bike is ever lost or stolen, this information will be used to help find it. Parking Services will give you a decal to attach to your bike.

and take it to the Office of Parking Services.

“Where is the MSU Office of Parking Services?”

Parking Services is located in the Roberts Building on Lee Boulevard next to Burger King.

“Where can I ride my bike on campus?”

You should ride on bike paths whenever they’re available. If there is no path, ride your bike on the right-hand side of the street. Bikes must be pushed - not ridden - on sidewalks and through crosswalks. Remember that your bike should have a light shining forward and a reflector on the rear. ***Don’t forget to wear a helmet!***

“Where can I park my bike?”

Park in any of the bike racks located in front of almost all buildings on campus, or you may park your bike inside your residence hall room. Remember not to park on a sidewalk or in a hallway. Be sure to lock your bike.

“Where can I buy a bike lock?”

Lots of items for you and your bike - including locks, helmets, reflectors, lights, and more - can be purchased at Wal-Mart and at the bicycle shops listed below. A bike lock at Wal-Mart sells for around \$15.00.

“Where in Starkville can I take my bike if it needs service?”
