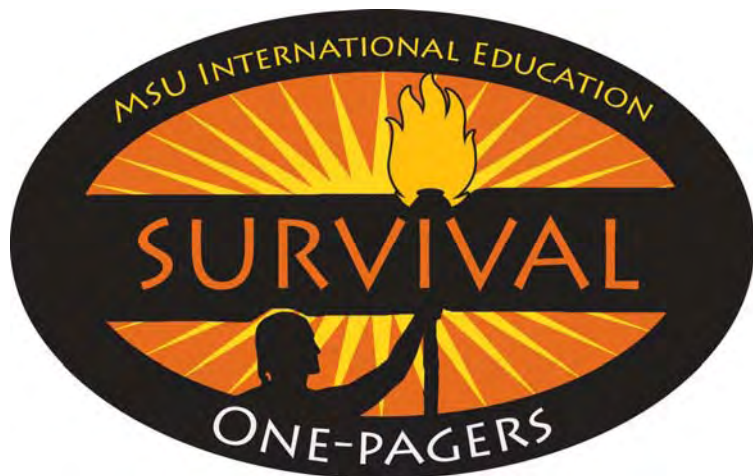


Campus Dining



There are lots of options for places to eat without ever leaving campus! Check out the information below!

“What is a meal plan, and how do I get one?”

A meal plan is a program here on campus that allows you to eat throughout the year at the Perry Cafeteria and at any of the other restaurants on campus. The plans come in different varieties, and you can purchase one by visiting Dining Services in the cafeteria or by calling 662-325-0923.

“Do I have to have a meal plan to eat on campus?”

No, you do not have to have a meal plan. All of the restaurants on campus will take cash and credit cards, and some will let you charge your meal to your student account.

“What restaurants are available on campus?”

In addition to Perry Cafeteria, located just south of Hull Hall on Old Main, there are a number of other food options on campus:

located just around the corner from Perry Cafeteria

Burger King at Roberts Hall

located next to MSU’s Office of Parking Services

located inside Mitchell Memorial Library on the 2nd floor

Colvard Student Union

The food court inside the Colvard Student Union features a number of fast-food restaurants including Chick-Fil-A, Sbarro, Mississippi Steak, and Bleeker Street.
