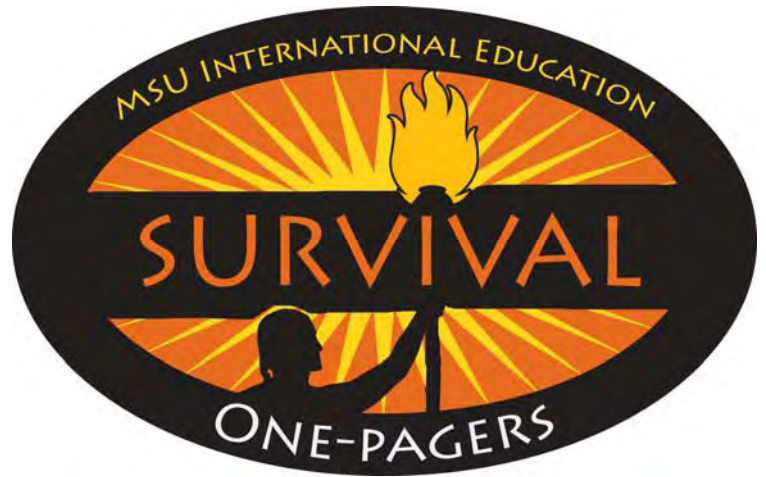


On-Campus Housing

If you want to live on the MSU campus, then here are some important tips to help you adjust to life in your new residence hall!



“How do I apply for a residence hall room on campus?”

Speak to Amy at the ESL Center if you want to live on campus, and she will help you if space is available.

“Am I required to live on campus?”

No, you do not have to live on campus. You may prefer to rent an apartment or find another housing arrangement. However, if you sign a housing contract, then you are required to live on campus until your contract ends in May or until you leave MSU.

“What is the International Living Learning Community?”

The International Living Learning Community is located in Critz Hall and is designed to match American students with international roommates. It is a great way to meet different people from all over the world, learn about new cultures, and practice your English.

“How much does campus housing cost?”

Costs vary by residence hall and whether you choose a single or private room. Check www.housing.msstate.edu for pricing information.

“If I have a problem with my room or roommate, who will help me?”

Talk to the resident assistant (RA) on your floor, and he or she will help you with the problem.

“If I don’t like living on campus, how do I break my housing contract?”

If you want to appeal your housing contract, then follow these steps: 1) go to the main housing office in Herbert Hall; 2) fill out a contract appeal form; 3) write a letter of explanation with as much detail as possible; and 4) submit the appeal form, letter, any supporting documentation (such as medical information), and a \$50 appeal fee to the housing office in Herbert Hall.
