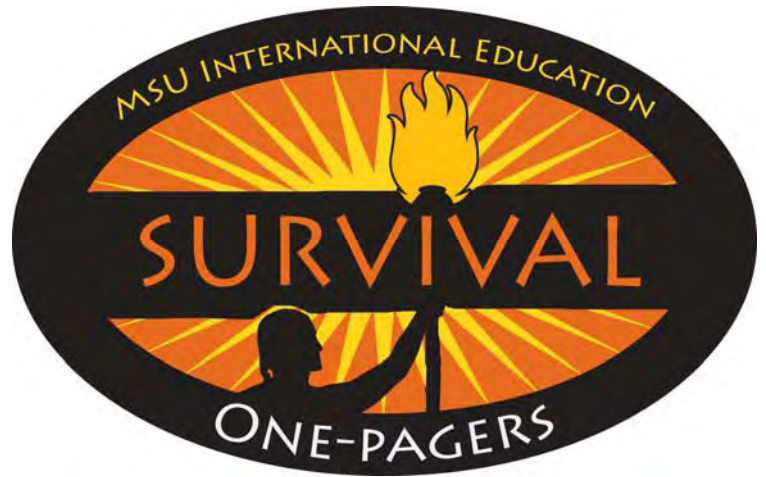


# Sanderson Center

## ***“What is the Sanderson Center?”***

The Joe Frank Sanderson Center opened in 1998 and provides MSU's students, staff and faculty access to weights, a swimming pool, a jogging track, a climbing wall, two gyms, aerobics classes, and much more. It has become one of the most popular student areas on campus.

## ***“May I use the Sanderson Center?”***

Yes! ESL students can use the Sanderson Center's facilities free-of-charge. Just go to the front desk, show your student ID card, and say you are an ESL student.

## ***“Where is the Sanderson Center?”***

The Sanderson Center is located behind Memorial Hall at the intersection of Coliseum Boulevard and Perry Street.

## ***“When is it open?”***

During the spring and fall semesters, the Sanderson Center is open

Monday - Friday 5.30am to 11.00pm

Saturday 10.00am to 8.00pm

Sunday 1.00pm to 11.00pm.

During the summer semester, the Sanderson Center is open

Monday - Friday 5.30am to 10.00pm

Saturday 10.00am to 8.00pm

Sunday 1.00pm to 8.00pm

## ***“What should I take with me when I go to the Sanderson Center?”***

Be sure and take your MSU student ID. You may also want to take a towel and a bottle of water.

There are lockers you can rent for \$20 per semester to store your books and clothes. If you rent a locker, free towel service is included for the semester. You may also bring your own lock and use a locker for free if you remove all of your items (including the lock) at the end of each day.
