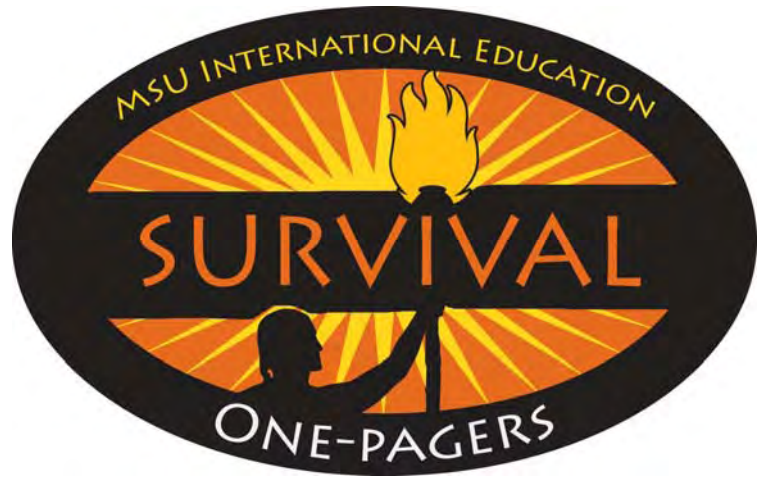


Travel Tips

“Am I allowed to rent a car in the United States?”

Yes, generally if you have an international or US driver’s license, are 21 years old, and have a major credit card in your name, you may rent a car. Remember, you must also have car insurance, which you may purchase from the rental company.

“What are some other travel tips that I should remember?”

Notify your bank that you will be traveling so that you won’t have problems using your credit or debit card.

Take your passport, I-20, etc. in case of emergency, but keep them in a safe place.

Most cities in the United States are safe for tourists, but all big cities can have crime. Remember to be careful if touring a new city alone (especially at night), and don’t go anywhere alone with a stranger.

Call Emergency 911, Molly (662-312-3772), or Alexis (662-617-3970) if you have problems.

“What if I am traveling within the United States during the break between classes?”

You do not HAVE to notify anyone, but it would be nice to tell Molly & Alexis where you are in case of an emergency.

“What if I am leaving the U.S. to visit another country?”

Molly or Amy must sign your I-20 before you leave the country so that you may re-enter.
