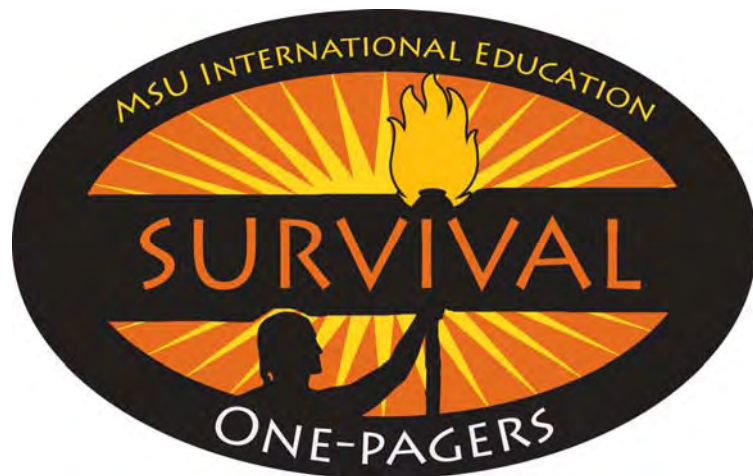


Wireless Internet Access



As an ESL student, you can have wireless Internet access added to your personal laptop for free to use all over campus! Check below to see how.

“What is wireless Internet access?”

Wireless Internet access is simply being able to access the Internet without being connected by wires to any Internet portal. MSU has wireless Internet network coverage in nearly every indoor and outdoor area of the main campus, and this wireless network is available to all students, staff, and faculty.

“Is wireless better than regular Internet?”

Not really. A typical wired network connection is at least four times faster than a wireless network connection, but using wireless access allows you to work on your laptop almost anywhere on campus you choose!

“How can I use MSU’s wireless Internet?”

To use MSU’s wireless Internet, you will need to have a wireless network adapter added onto your laptop. Take your laptop to Information Technology Services located in 108 Allen Hall between 8:00am and 4:00pm Monday through Friday. Ask the person at the front desk to help you get wireless access installed onto your laptop.

“What if I have a problem accessing the wireless Internet?”

If you have any problems with your laptop on campus or problems accessing the wireless network, you can report your problem to Information Technology Services, and someone there will help you. Call Information Technology Services at 662.325.0631 Monday through Friday between 7:30am and 5:00pm, or visit them in Allen Hall and tell the person at the desk about your problem.
