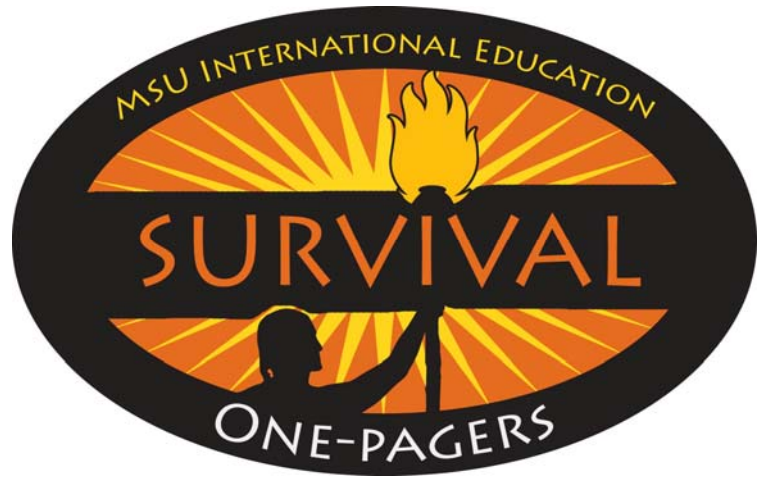


Cheese Store

Want to get a little taste of one of MSU's oldest traditions? Check out MSU's MAFES cheese store! You can buy items there made at MSU, such as cheese, ice cream, milk, eggs, meat, jam, jelly, coffee, juice, and much more!



“What is the MAFES cheese store?”

It is the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station cheese store.

“What can you buy from the cheese store?”

The MAFES cheese store sells many kinds of milk products such as different kinds of cheese, ice cream, and different flavors of milk. Also, it sells jam, coffee and meat.

“What time does it open and close?”

The MAFES Sales Store is open only on weekdays from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

“When was the cheese store founded and why?”

It was founded in 1938 by Professor F.H. Herzer. He wanted it to help the university by bringing in money. Additionally, he wanted to provide cheap milk products for the students and educational benefits for the food science students.

“Where is the cheese store located?”

The MAFES Sales Store is located in the Herzer Building on the Mississippi State University campus behind the cafeteria. It is just in front of the bookstore and across the street from Dorman Hall.

“What is the most popular thing in the cheese store?”

The most popular products in the cheese store are the ice cream and the Edam cheese.
