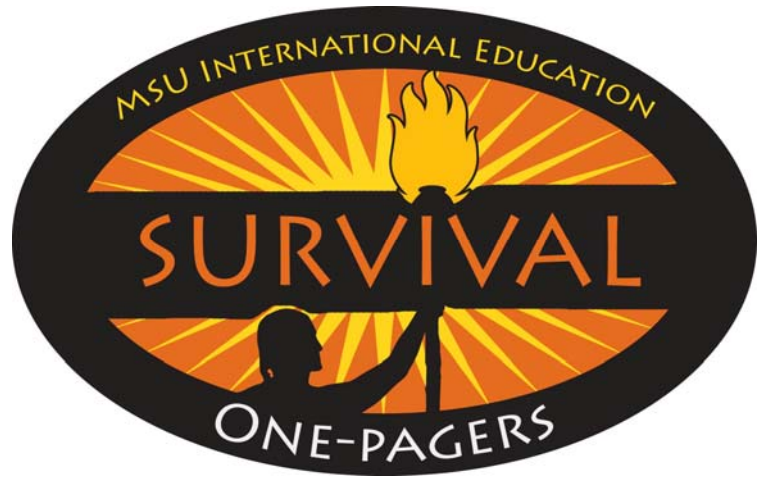


Colvard Union

"What is the Colvard Union ?"

The Colvard Union was named after president Dr. Dean W. Colvard. It was built in 1964. It closed in 2006 for renovation and reopened in 2008.

"When is it open?"

Monday – Sunday 6:30 a.m. – 10 p.m.

"What kind of stores are in the Union ?"

The Union has a food court, Starbucks, C3 convenience store, hair salon, and ATM machines.

"How many floors are in the Union ?"

The Union has three main floors. The first floor has a food court and barber shop. The second floor has student leadership offices and the Holmes Cultural Diversity Center. The third floor has the Center for Student Involvement (Room 314) and the Conversation Connections location (Room 329).

"What is the mission of the Union ?"

The mission of the Union is to promote student involvement, student leadership skills, and student social activities.
